NEW EVIMAIL ENHANCEMENT; MAIL IN COPY

Would you like to assign copy recipients to your emails?

EviMail now allows you to send a certified communication to one recipient, and to copy other people.

These "copy" recipients will receive an uncertified email, in which the links and action buttons that are only active for the original recipient will have been deactivated.

Here's how to use it.

WHAT HAS CHANGED?

Now in EviMail you will have the option to copy one or more persons, who will receive a copy of the original certified communication issued.

WHAT DOES IT IMPACT ME?

Not at all. It is an incremental function.

IS THERE A LIMIT OF MAILS IN COPY?

Yes, there is a maximum of 10 mailing addresses in copy.

IS THERE AN ADDITIONAL COST?

Yes, for more information about the cost, please contact your sales representative.

HOW CAN I USE THIS FUNCTION WHEN ISSUING AN EVIMAIL FROM MY WEBSITE?

First fill in the recipient's details, then under "Carbon copy" enter the e-mail address and the names of the recipients you wish to receive a copy of the certified communication. Finally, write the subject line, the content of the EviMail to be sent and that's it!

HOW TO SEE THE EMAILS IN COPY OF THE EVIMAIL I HAVE SENT?

Go to your website and in the section "Evictions" / "My EviMails" you can see the details of the communications issued.

From your EviMail details, you will see (if these exist) the emails in copy, in the "Recipients in copy" section:

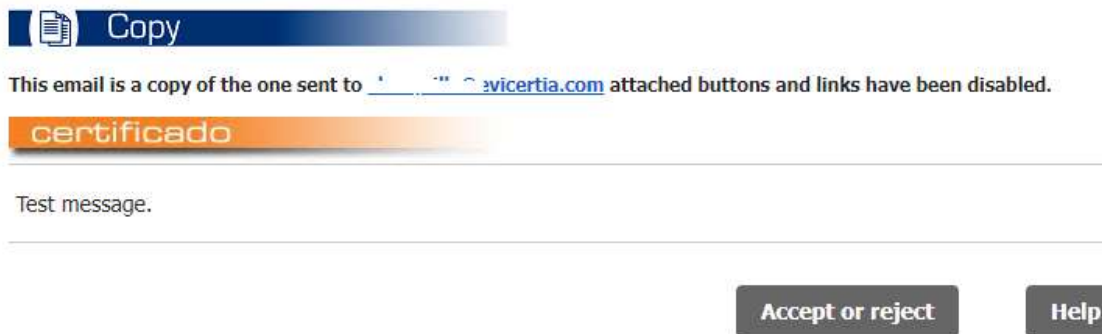

The recipient in copy will receive an email that looks like this:



HOW CAN I USE THIS FUNCTION WHEN ISSUING AN EVIMAIL USING WEBSERVICES?

EviMailSubmit

In order to use this functionality by Webservices, the **"carbonCopy"** parameter, which is a list consisting of the name and e-mail address of the persons to whom the copy is to be sent, must be reported:

EviMailQuery

When requesting an EviMail query through the **EviMailQuery** web service, the **EviMailQuery** web service will return the configuration that has been made in the copies.

Below is an example of what the EviMailQuery web service returns:
